

Metalottery Cookie Policy

1. Introduction

The website, www.metalottery.win (hereinafter: "the website") uses cookies and other related technologies (for convenience all technologies are referred to as "cookies"). In the document below we inform you about the use of cookies on the website.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small file of information, letters, and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

Reference to a "cookie" means the software or technology that can collect, transmit, or recognise information about your visits to the website.

2. Types of cookies placed

The following cookies may be placed on the website:

Strictly necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation of the website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of the website.

Functionality cookies. These are used to recognise you when you return to the website. This enables personalisation of content for users, and remembering user preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

Analytical or performance cookies. These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around the website when they are using it. This helps improve the way the website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

Targeting/Marketing cookies. These cookies record your visit to the website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make the website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

Google Analytics Please note that the Services use analytics services provided by Google Analytics. Website analytics refers to a set of tools used to collect and analyse anonymous usage information, enabling us to better understand how our Services are used. This, in turn, enables us to improve the website and the services/products offered through it. We use first-party cookies. Third parties may also use third-party cookies in the Services over which we have no control. Third-party cookies may be used when the website incorporates elements from other websites or when the browser or other software fetches elements from other websites. **If you want to learn more about how third parties use your data via third-party cookies, please read the privacy statements provided on their websites.** These third-party cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies.

3. Consent to use of cookies

Cookies are saved on your device, after you have been notified and have consented to them, except where strictly necessary or functional cookies are used - in that case no explicit consent is required.

By clicking accept to the use of any cookies at the message that pops up on your screen asking you to accept, customise, or reject cookies, as may be available for the relevant category of cookies, you are agreeing to our placing cookies on your browser or the hard drive of your computer or your mobile device or your tablet or any other device from which you access the website.

You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser cookies at any time and withdraw your consent at any time, or to alert you when websites set or access cookies, by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser (see more information below).

If you disable or refuse the use of cookies on the website, at any time, please note that some parts of the website may become inaccessible or not function properly. To find out more about cookies, including how to manage and delete them, you may visit www.allaboutcookies.org.

4. How to delete and disable our cookies any time

You disable and/or refuse cookies by rejecting their use when a relevant message pops up or by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies.

However, if you block all (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of the website.

5. Change cookie settings

Please note that internet browsers allow you to change your cookie settings. These settings are usually found in the 'options' or 'preferences' menu of your internet browser. In order to understand how to change your cookie settings, use the “help” option in your internet browser or visit the relevant pages on cookie settings in Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome, or Safari.

6. Changes to this Policy

We may make changes to this Cookie Policy from time to time. We will update this Cookie Policy from time to time to reflect any changes to the website. The changes will be effective from the date they are posted on our website. We encourage you to review this policy periodically to be informed of how the website uses cookies.

7. Your personal data rights

If you are a resident of the EU, you have the following rights in relation to your personal data. Please note that some of these rights will only apply in certain circumstances and some of them may be

limited where we have an overriding interest or legal obligation to continue to process the data or where data may be exempt from disclosure due to reasons of confidentiality obligations.

Access: you may ask us if we are processing your data and, if we are, you can request access to your personal data. This enables you to receive a copy of the personal data we hold about you and certain other information about it.

Correction: you may request that any incomplete or inaccurate personal data we hold about you is corrected.

Erasure: you may ask us to delete or remove personal data in certain circumstances. There are also certain exceptions where we may refuse a request for erasure, for example, where the personal data is required for compliance with law or in connection with claims.

Restriction: you may ask us to suspend the processing of certain of your personal data about you, for example if you want us to establish its accuracy or the reason for processing it.

Transfer: you may ask us to help you request the transfer certain of your personal data to another party.

Objection: where we are processing your personal data based on legitimate interests (or those of a third party) and you may challenge this. However, we may be entitled to continue processing your information. You also have the right to object where we are processing your personal data for direct marketing purposes.

Automated decisions: you may contest any automated decision made about you where this has a legal or similar significant effect and ask for it to be reconsidered.

Consent: where we are processing personal data with consent, you can withdraw your consent.
